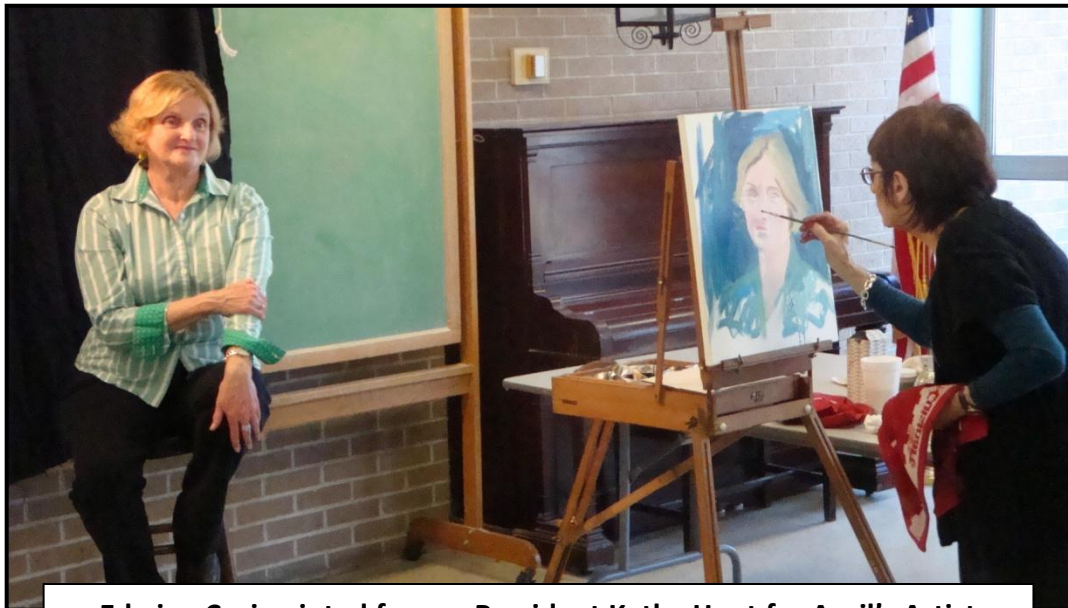




A word from our new President Liz Boston,
